- ◆ The act of Tawbah

#1 Tawbah - The right mindset

- ◆ To err is human
- ◆ The door of repentance is always open

فَمَنْ تَابَ مِنْ بَعْدِ ظُلْمِهِ وَأَصْلَحَ فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ يَتُوبُ عَلَيْهِ
إِنَّ اللَّهَ غَفُورٌ رَحِيمٌ ﴿٣٩﴾

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39. But whoever repents after his wrongdoing and reforms, indeed, Allah will turn to him in forgiveness. Indeed, Allah is Forgiving and Merciful.

Surah Al-Maidah; Ayah 39

#1 Tawbah - Conditions of repentance

- ◆ the person gives up the sin straight away,
- ◆ that he/she regrets what has happened in the past,
- ◆ that he/she resolves not to go back to the thing he/she has repented from,
- ◆ that he/she restores people's rights or property if sin involved wrongdoing towards others, and
- ◆ that he/she repents before the agony of death is upon him. Allah says (interpretation of the meaning):

“Allah accepts only the repentance of those who do evil in ignorance and foolishness and repent soon afterwards; it is they whom Allah will forgive and Allah is Ever All-Knower, All-Wise.

And of no effect is the repentance of those who continue to do evil deeds until death faces one of them and he says: ‘Now I repent;’ nor of those who die while they are disbelievers. For them We have prepared a painful torment” [al-Nisa 4:17-18]

#1 Tawbah - The act of Tawbah

- ◆ Seek for forgiveness
- ◆ Solat at - tawbah

Narrated Abu Huraira:

I heard Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) saying." By Allah!
I ask for forgiveness from Allah and turn to Him in
repentance more than seventy times a day."

#2 Check Quality of Solah

#2 Check quality of Solah (prayer)

- ◆ Is our solah according to how Rasullullah (peace and blessings of Allah be upon him) pray?
- ◆ Do we know the meaning?
- ◆ Do we pray on time?
- ◆ Do we have khusyu'? (focus, calm, concentrate)
- ◆ How is our wudu' and clothing?

#3 Forgive and Ask for Forgiveness

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- ◆ Forgive people to gain Allah's forgiveness
- ◆ Qalbin Saleem leads to Jannah
- ◆ Follow for the Sunnah and our Prophets
- ◆ Consider life a constant test

وَلَا يَأْتَلِ أُولُوا الْفَضْلِ مِنْكُمْ وَالسَّعَةِ أَنْ يُؤْتُوا أُولِي
الْقُرْبَى وَالْمَسْكِينِ وَالْمُهَاجِرِينَ فِي سَبِيلِ اللَّهِ وَلْيَعْفُوا
وَلْيَصْفَحُوا أَلَا تُحِبُّونَ أَنْ يَغْفِرَ اللَّهُ لَكُمْ وَاللَّهُ غَفُورٌ
