

#1 Tawbah - The right mindset

#1 Tawbah - Conditions of repentance

- the person gives up the sin straight away,
- that he/she regrets what has happened in the past,
- that he/she resolves not to go back to the thing he/she has repented from,
- that he/she restores people's rights or property if sin involved wrongdoing towards others, and
- that he/she repents before the agony of death is upon him. Allah says (interpretation of the meaning):

whom Allah will forgive and Allah is Ever All-Knower, All-Wise.

- "Allah accepts only the repentance of those who do evil in ignorance and foolishness and repent soon afterwards; it is they
- And of no effect is the repentance of those who continue to do evil deeds until death faces one of them and he says: 'Now I repent;' nor of those who die while they are disbelievers. For them We have prepared a painful torment" [al-Nisa 4:17-18]

Seríousness of Debts

• The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) refrained from offering the funeral prayer for one who had died owing two dínars, untíl Abu Qataadah (may Allaah be pleased with him) promised to pay it off for him. When he saw him the following day and said, I have paid it off, the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Now his skin has become cool for him." Musnad Ahmad (3/629); classed as hasan by al-Nawawi in al-Khalaasah (2/931) and by Ibn Muflih in al-Adaab al-Shar'iyyah (1/104).



Seríousness of Debts

 "The soul of the believer is suspended because of his debt until it is paid off." Narrated by al-Tirmidhi (1078)

 Ibn Umar (ra) said, Fear Allaah and do not die in debt, lest it be taken from your good deeds when there will be no dinars and no dirhams. Musannaf Abdur-Razzaq



Take Action

It was narrated from Abu Huraírah that the Messenger of Allah (() saíd: "The best of you - or among the best of you - are those who pay off their debts in the best manner." Sunan Ibn Majah 2423
"The one who takes people's wealth intending to pay it back. Allaah

 "The one who takes people's wealth intending to pay it back, Allaah will pay it back for him, and the one who takes it intending to destroy it, Allaah will destroy him." Narrated by al-Bukhaari (2387).

#8 Prepare Híbah (Gífts) and Wasiyyah (Will)



Híbah (Gífts) - Fair and Just

That it is absolutely haraam to differentiate between them. This is the well known view among the Hanbalis (see Kashshaaf al-Qinaa', 4/310; al-Insaaf, 7/138). This is also the view of the Zaahiriyyah (i.e., it is the same whether the differentiation is done for a reason or for no reason).

2 - That it is haraam to differentiate between them unless that is for a legitimate shar'i reason. This was narrated from Ahmad (al-Insaaf, 7/139) and was the view favoured by Ibn Qudaamah (al-Mughni, 5/664) and Ibn Taymiyah (Majmoo' al-Fataawa, 31/295).



Hibah (Gifts)

• The evidence quoted by both groups that say that it is haraam to differentiate between one's children is the report narrated by al-Bukhaari (2586) and Muslim (1623) from al-Nu'maan ibn Basheer, who said that his father brought him to the Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) and said: "I have given this son of mine a slave who used to belong to me." The Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said, "have you given a similar gift to all of your children?" He said, "No." The Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said, "Then take (your gift) back."



Hibah (Gifts)

- this, for I do not bear witness to injustice."

• According to another version (al-Bukhaari, 2587; Muslim, 1623), al-Nu'maan ibn Basheer said: "My father gave me a gift of some of his wealth, but my mother, 'Amrah bint Rawaahah, said, 'I will not approve of it until you ask the Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) to bear witness to it.' So my father went to the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) to ask him to bear witness to the gift. The Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said to him, 'Have you done the same for all of your children?' He said, 'No.' He said, 'Fear Allaah and treat your children justly.' So my father came back and took back that gift."

 According to a version narrated by Muslim, the Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "O Basheer, do you have any other children?" He said, "Yes." He said, "Have you given all of them a similar gift?" He said, "No." He said, "Then do not ask me to bear witness to



Híbah (Gífts)

The evidence in this hadeeth is clear:
1 - The Prophet commanded justice, and a command implies that it is obligatory.

2 – He explained that showing preference to one child or singling him out to the exclusion of the others is falsehood and injustice, in addition to his refusal to bear witness to it and his commanding him to take back his gift. All of that indicates that differentiating between one's children is haraam.



Wasiyyah (Will)

 And it (writing a will) may be obligatory with regard to the dues of others where there is no proof, lest they be lost or neglected, because the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon hím) saíd: "It is not permissible for any Muslim who has something to will to stay for two nights without having his last will and testament written and kept ready with him." (Narrated by al-Bukhaari, al-Wasaayaa 2533)



Wasiyyah (Will)

• The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Allaah was being generous to you when He allowed you to give one-third of your wealth (in charity) when you die, to increase your good deeds." (Narrated by Ibn Maajah, al-Wasaayaa, 2700; classed as hasan by al-Albaani in Saheeh Sunan
