Benefits of Seeking Forgiveness

Do you want to have peace of mind, reassurance, and joy?

You should ask for the forgiveness of Allah, The Almighty. Allah, The Almighty, Says (what means): *{And [saying], "Seek Forgiveness of your Lord and repent to Him, [and] He Will Let you enjoy a good provision}* [Quran 11: 3]

Do you want to have a strong body and be healthy, and be free of diseases and disabilities? Is so, you should ask for the forgiveness of Allah, The Almighty. Allah, The Almighty, Says (what means): *{Ask Forgiveness of your Lord and then repent to Him. He will send [rain from] the sky upon you in showers and Increase you in strength [added] to your strength.}* [Quran 11: 52]

Do you want to drive disasters and accidents away and be safe from Fitnah (trials) and afflictions? You should ask for the forgiveness of Allah, The Almighty. Allah, The Almighty, Says (what means): *{But Allah would not punish them while you, [O Muhammad], are among them, and Allah would not punish them while they seek forgiveness.}* [Quran 8: 33]

Do you want rain in continuing showers, righteous children, lawful money, and expanded sustenance? Then you should ask for the forgiveness of Allah. Allah, The Almighty, Says (what means): *{And said, 'Ask forgiveness of your Lord. Indeed, He Is ever a Perpetual Forgiver. He will send [rain from] the sky upon you in [continuing] showers. And give you increase in wealth and children and provide for you gardens and provide for you rivers.}* [Quran 71: 10- 12]

Do you want your sins to be forgiven, your rewards to be increased, and your rank to be elevated? You should ask for the forgiveness of Allah, The Almighty. Allah Says (what means): *{And say, 'Relieve us of our burdens.' We will [then] forgive your sins for you, and We will Increase the doers of good [in goodness and reward].}* [Quran 2: 58]

Asking for forgiveness is the successful remedy for getting rid of sins. This is why the

Prophet ﷺ ordered us to ask for the forgiveness of Allah, The Almighty, frequently.

The Prophet ﷺ said: *"O people! Ask for the forgiveness of Allah and repent to Him as I ask for the forgiveness of Allah and repent to Him one hundred times a day."*

Allah, The Almighty, is satisfied with the one who asks for His forgiveness as this person acknowledges his sin as if he says, "O Allah! I have made a mistake and I was negligent with Your rights as I wronged myself and the devil tempted me and my soul, which is a persistent enjoiner of evil, betrayed me. I relied on Your mercy, forgiveness, and forbearance. Now, I come to You while repenting and regretting, so forgive me, remove my sins and mistakes as I do not have any other Lord but You. O Allah! Even if my sins are grave, Your Forgiveness is greater and more comprehensive."

"....."My Lord! I have definitely wronged my soul, so forgive me."....." (Qur'aan; 28:16)

10 Benefits of Asking God's Forgiveness

We should make it a habit to beseech Allah's [forgiveness](#) as much as we can. We will receive numerous benefits for doing so.

The following are but a few of them:

● Forgiveness of Sins

Allah quotes Noah speaking to his people:

Ask forgiveness from your Lord; for He is Oft-Forgiving. ([71:10](#))

● It is a Reason for the Rain to Fall

Noah continues:

He will send rain to you in abundance. ([71:11](#))

● Increase in Wealth

Noah continues:

And give you increase in wealth and children. ([71:12](#))

● Prosperity and Success

Noah continues:

And provide gardens for you and provide rivers for you. ([71:12](#))

This expresses the good of this world that Allah provides us. The term "gardens" here refers to worldly provisions as well as the gardens of Paradise in the Hereafter. It also refers to the good that comes as a result of the water Allah provides to the Earth.

● Increased Strength

This comprehends all kinds of strength. As Prophet Hud said to his people:

O my people! Ask forgiveness of your Lord, then turn unto Him repentant; He will cause the sky to rain abundance on you and will add unto you strength to your strength. (11: 52)

This includes the inner strength which comes from having peace of mind and a conscience that is free from the burden of sin.

• A good Life

Allah says:

Ask forgiveness of your Lord and turn to Him repentant. He will cause you to enjoy a fair estate until a time appointed. (11: 3)

Life is good to those who are righteous and [God-fearing](#). It is also good to those who return to Allah in repentance, asking His forgiveness, and compensating for their sins by engaging in good deeds.

• Relief from Hardships

Allah says:

Allah will not punish them while they are asking His forgiveness. (8: 33)

This is because when we [seek forgiveness](#), it dissuades us from persisting in sin. We are realizing and acknowledging our mistakes, not rationalizing them.

• Allah's Mercy

Allah says:

Besech Allah's forgiveness, that perchance you will be shown mercy. (27: 46)

• It Atones for the Mistakes Made when we Interact with One Another

In the latter part of his life, whenever the Prophet stood up from meeting with people, he used to say:

"Glory and praise be to Allah. I bear witness that there is no God but Him. I beseech His forgiveness and turn to Him in repentance." (Al-Bukhari and Muslim)

The first time he did this, a man asked him:

"You have said something you have never said before."

The Prophet replied:

"It atones for whatever happened during the meeting."

• It Placates our Fears and Worries

The Prophet said:

“Whoever asks Allah’s forgiveness often, Allah will give them relief from every worry, make a way out for them from every difficulty, and provide for them from whence they least expect it.” (Abu Dawud)

Ibn al-Qayyim comments in *Zad al-Ma`ad*:

As for the effect that beseeching Allah’s forgiveness has on our fears, worries, and difficulties, one thing all rational people from all nations and faith traditions agree upon is that sins and corruption cause anxiety, fear, and depression, as well as [diseases](#) of the heart.

Indeed, even after the [sinful](#) people have had their fill from indulging in sin, the resultant anxiety and worry that remains in their hearts causes them to return to the sin again to ward away those feelings. One of the most notorious sinners penned these verses:

A draught I drank for the pure pleasure that it gave

The next to cure what the first draught had made me crave!

Since this is the effect that sins and transgressions have on the heart, the only real cure is to beseech Allah’s forgiveness.

It seems that [Ibn al-Qayyim](#) is alluding to addiction, which not only relates to alcohol and drug use, but to any habitual sin, like illicit affairs and pornography.

This requires appealing to Allah for forgiveness frequently, as well as seeking treatment, engaging in wholesome activities, and keeping good company.

[Addiction](#) of any kind requires professional help, since addiction itself compels the perpetration of the act, even in the absence of any pleasure.

The pleasure of the activity might have been what got the addict started in the first place, but then when it turns into a psychological or physical dependency, the compulsion to do it remains even in the absence of any positive sensation.

The following advice is attributed to [Luqman](#):

“My son, make it your tongue’s habit to say: ‘O Allah, forgive me,’ since there are times during the day that no petitioner is turned down.” (*Shu`ab al-Iman* (1120))

Aisha said:

“Blessed are those who have in their record of deeds that they sought Allah’s forgiveness often.”

Abu al-Minhal said:

“The best neighbour one can have in the grave is the forgiveness that one had sought from Allah.”

Qatadah said:

“This Quran reveals to you your affliction and its cure. Your sins are your affliction and the cure is to ask Allah’s forgiveness.”

Al-Hasan said:

“Ask Allah’s forgiveness frequently, when you are at home, when you are dining, when you are on the road, when you are shopping, and at your gatherings. You never know when Allah will bestow His forgiveness.”

O Allah! We have wronged ourselves greatly, and no one forgives sins but You, so forgive us and have mercy on us. Indeed, You are the Oft-Forgiving, Most Merciful.

Riyad as-Salihin

Riyad as-Salihin is a selection of hadith compiled by Imam Yahya ibn Sharaf an-Nawawi. It is one of the most widely known and read books of hadith all over the world, containing approximately 1,900 carefully chosen hadith on ethics, manners, worship, knowledge, and other topics compiled from the Six Books of hadith. It is practical and accessible to Muslims of all levels.

- **Al-Agharr Al-Muzani (May Allah be pleased with him) said:**

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "Sometimes I perceive a veil over my heart, and I supplicate Allah for forgiveness a hundred times in a day."

We counted Messenger's saying a hundred times during one single sitting: Rabb- ighfir li, wa tubb 'alayya, innaka Antat-Tawwabur-Rahim. (My Rubb! Forgive me and pardon me. Indeed, You are the Oft-Returning with compassion and Ever Merciful.)

• **Ibn Mas'ud (May Allah be pleased with him) said:**

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "He who says: 'Astaghfir ullah-alladhi la ilaha illa Huwal-Haiyul-Qayyumu, wa atubu ilaihi (I seek the forgiveness of Allah, there is no true god except Allah, the Ever-Living, the Self-Subsisting, and I turn to Him in repentance),' his sins will be forgiven even if he should have run away from the battlefield (while he was engaged in fighting for the Cause of Allah)."

[Abu Dawud, At-Tirmidhi and Al-Hakim (on conditions of Al-Bukhari and Muslim for accepting Hadith)].

وعن ابن مسعود رضي الله عنه قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه وسلم: "من قال: أستغفر الله الذي لا إله إلا هو الحي القيوم وأتوب إليه، غفرت ذنوبه، وإن كان قد فر من الزحف" ((رواه أبو داود والترمذي والحاكم، وقال: حديث صحيح على شرط البخاري ومسلم)).

• **Shaddad bin Aus (May Allah be pleased with him) said:**

The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "The best supplication for seeking forgiveness (Syed-ul-Istighfar) is to say: 'Allahumma Anta Rabbi, la ilaha illa Anta, khalaqtani wa ana 'abduka, wa ana 'ala 'ahdika wa wa'dika mastata'tu, a'udhu bika min sharri ma sana'tu, abu'u laka bini'matika 'alayya, wa abu'u bidhanbi faghfir li, fa innahu la yaghfirudh-dhunuba illa Anta. (O Allah! You are my Rubb. There is no true god except You. You have created me, and I am Your slave, and I hold to Your Covenant as far as I can. I seek refuge in You from the evil of what I have done. I acknowledge the favours that You have bestowed upon me, and I confess my sins. Pardon me, for none but You has the power to pardon).' He who supplicates in these terms during the day with firm belief in it and dies on the same day (before the evening), he will be one of the dwellers of Jannah; and if anyone supplicates in these terms during the night with firm belief in it and dies before the morning, he will be one of the dwellers of Jannah."

وعن شداد بن أوس رضي الله عنه عن النبي صلى الله عليه وسلم قال: "سيد الاستغفار أن يقول العبد: اللهم أنت ربي، لا إله إلا أنت، خلقتني وأنا عبدك، وأنا على عهدك ووعدك ما استطعت أعوذ بك من شر ما صنعت أبوء لك بنعمتك علي، وأبوء بذنبي، فأغفر لي فإنه لا يغفر الذنوب إلا أنت، من قالها من

النهار موقنا بها، فمات من يومه قبل أن يمسي، فهو من أهل الجنة، ومن قالها من الليل وهو موقن بها فمات قبل أن يصبح، فهو من أهل الجنة” ((رواه البخاري)). (1)

- **Thauban (May Allah be pleased with him) reported:**

Whenever the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) finished his Salat (prayer), he would beg forgiveness three times **[by saying, 'Astaghfirullah' (3 times)]** and then he would say: "Allahumma Antas-Salamu, wa minkas-Salamu, tabarakta ya Dhal-Jalali wal-Ikram. (O Allah! You are the Bestower of security and security comes from You; Blessed are You. O Possessor of glory and honour)." Imam Al-Auza'i (one of the subnarrators) of this Hadith was asked: "How forgiveness should be sought?" He replied: "I say: Astaghfirullah, Astaghfirullah (I seek forgiveness from Allah. I seek forgiveness from Allah)."

- وعن ثوبان رضي الله عنه قال: كان رسول الله صلى الله عليه وسلم إذا انصرف من صلاته ، استغفر الله ثلاثاً وقال: "اللهم أنت السلام، ومنك السلام، تباركت يا ذا الجلال والإكرام" قيل للأوزاعي- وهو أحد رواة: كيف الإستغفار؟ قال: يقول: "أستغفر الله ، أستغفر الله" ((رواه مسلم)).

Prior to his demise, the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) used to supplicate frequently: Subhan Allahi wa bihamdihi; Astaghfirullah wa atubu ilaihi (Allah is free from imperfection, and I begin with praising Him. I beg forgiveness from Allah and I turn to Him in repentance.)

I heard the Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) saying, "Allah, the Exalted, has said: 'O son of Adam! I shall go on forgiving you so long as you pray to Me and aspire for My forgiveness whatever may be your sins. O son of Adam! I do not care even if your sins should pile up to the sky and should you

beg pardon of Me, I would forgive you. O son of Adam! If you come to Me with an earthful of sins and meet Me, not associating anything with Me in worship, I will certainly grant you as much pardon as will fill the earth."

وعن أنس رضي الله عنه قال: سمعت رسول الله صلى الله عليه وسلم يقول: "قال الله تعالى: يا ابن آدم إنك ما دعوتني ورجوتني غفرت لك ما كان منك ولا أبالي، يا ابن آدم لو بلغت ذنوبك عنان السماء، ثم استغفرتني، غفرت لك ولا أبالي، يا ابن آدم إنك لو أتيتني بقراب الأرض خطايا، ثم لقيتني لا تشرك بي شيئاً، لأتيتك بقرابها مغفرة". • **Ibn 'Umar (May Allah be pleased with them) said:**

The Prophet (ﷺ) said, "O women folk! You should give charity and be diligent in seeking Allah's forgiveness because I have seen (i.e., on the Night of the Ascension to the highest heavens) that dwellers of the Hell are women." A woman amongst them said: "Why is it that the majority of the dwellers of Hell are women?" The Prophet (ﷺ) replied, "You curse frequently and are ungrateful to your husbands. In spite of your lacking in wisdom and failing in religion, you are depriving the wisest of men of their intelligence." Upon this the woman asked: "What is the deficiency in our wisdom and in our religion?" He (ﷺ) replied, "Your lack of wisdom can be well judged from the fact that the evidence of two women is equal to that one man. You do not offer Salat (prayer) for some days and you do not fast (the whole of) Ramadan sometimes, it is a deficiency in religion."

باب بيان ما أعد الله للمؤمنين في الجنة

- **Jabir (May Allah be pleased with him) reported:**

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "The inhabitants of Jannah will eat and drink therein, but they will not have to pass excrement, to blow their noses or to urinate. Their food will be digested producing belch which will give out a smell like that of musk. They will be inspired to declare the freedom of Allah from imperfection and proclaim His Greatness as easily as you breathe."

وعن جابر رضي الله عنه قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه وسلم: "يأكل أهل الجنة فيها، ويشربون، ولا يتغوطون، ولا يتمخطون، ولا يبولون، ولكن طعامهم ذلك جشاء كرشح المسك، يلهمون التسبيح والتكبير، كما يلهمون النفس" ((رواه مسلم)).

'No person knows what is kept hidden for them of joy as a reward for what they used to do.'" (32:17)

- **Abu Hurairah (May Allah be pleased with him) said:**

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "The first group (of people) to enter Jannah will be shining like the moon on a full-moon night. Then will come those who follow them who will be like the most shining planet in the sky. They will not stand in need of urinating or relieving of nature or of spitting or blowing their noses. Their combs will be of gold and their sweat will smell like musk; in their censers the aloes-wood will be used. Their wives will be large eyed maidens. All men will be alike in the form of their father 'Adam, sixty cubits tall."

Another narration is: The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "Their utensils will be of gold, their perspiration will smell like musk; everyone of them will have two wives; the marrow of the bones of the wives' legs will be seen through the flesh out of excessive beauty. They (i.e., the people of Jannah) will neither have difference, nor enmity (hatred) amongst themselves; their hearts will be as if one heart, and they will be glorifying Allah in the morning and in the afternoon."

وعنه قال: قال رسول الله صلى الله عليه وسلم "أول زمرة يدخلون الجنة على صورة القمر ليلة البدر، ثم الذين يلونهم على أشد كوكب دري في السماء إضاءة، لا يبولون ولا يتغوطون، ولا يتقلون، ولا يتمخطون، أمشاطهم الذهب، وريحهم المسك، ومجامرهم الألوة -عود الطيب- أزواجهم الحورالعين، على خلق رجل واحد، على صورة أبيهم آدم ستون ذراعاً في السماء" ((متفق عليه)).

وفي رواية للبخاري ومسلم: أنبتهم فيها الذهب، ورشحهم المسك، ولكل واحد منهم زوجتان يرى مخ ساقهما من وراء اللحم من الحسن، لا اختلاف بينهم، ولا تباغض: قلوبهم قلب رجل واحد، يسبحون الله بكرة وعشياً. قوله: (على خلق رجل واحد). رواه بعضهم بفتح الخاء واسكان اللام وبعضهم بضمهما وكلاهما صحيح.

• **Al-Mughirah bin Shu'bah (May Allah be pleased with him) said:**

The Messenger of Allah (ﷺ) said, "Musa (Moses) (ﷺ) asked his Rubb: 'Who amongst the inhabitants of Jannah will be the lowest in rank?' He said: 'It will be a person who will be admitted into Jannah last of all when all the dwellers of Jannah have entered Jannah. It will be said to him: Enter Jannah. But he will say: O my Rubb! How should I enter while the people have settled in their apartments and taken their shares? It will be said to him: Will you be satisfied and pleased if you have a kingdom like that of a monarch of the world? He will say: I will be content, my Rubb. Allah will say: For you is that, and like that and like that and like that and like that. He will say at the fifth time: I am well-pleased, my Rubb. Allah will say: It is for you and ten times more like it. You will have whatever your soul desires and whatever your eyes could delight in. He will say: I am well-pleased, my Rubb.' Musa (ﷺ) said: 'Who will be of the highest rank in Jannah.' Allah said: 'They are those whom I chose and I established their honour with My Own Hand. I attest with My Seal that they will be blessed with such bounties as no eye has seen, no ear has heard and no human mind has perceived.'"

Asking for forgiveness

Is it too late or too much to ask for God's forgiveness?

Humans make mistakes and commit sins. That's natural. But what is not natural is that we sometimes don't ask for forgiveness afterwards. The Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Every son of Adam sins, and the best of those who sin are those who repent." Narrated by al-Tirmidhi, 2499; classed as hasan by al-Albaani. It is expected to fall short sometimes. Therefore, we should be ready and eager to repent once a sin is committed.

The questions that you may be posing now are: "Is it too late to ask for forgiveness? Is it too much to ask for forgiveness as I have committed a lot of sins?" The answer to the first question is in the following Hadiths. It was narrated by Abu 'Abd al-Rahmaan 'Abd-Allaah ibn 'Umar ibn al-Khattaab (may Allaah be pleased with them) that the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Allaah will accept the repentance of His slave so long as the death-rattle has not yet reached his throat." Narrated by al-Tirmidhi. As long as there is no gurgling or rattling made in the throat (which is an indication of near death), we can repent. Moreover, there is another condition for repentance to be accepted. One can't ask for forgiveness when the sun rises from the West (which is one of the Hour's big signs- and the hour refers the end of life and the beginning of the Resurrection and Judgment). Al-Bukhaari (4635) and Muslim (157) narrated that Abu Hurayrah (may Allaah be pleased with him) said: the Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "The hour will not come until the sun rises from its Maghrib (West). When people witness this, they will believe. This will happen when 'faith no longer benefits the soul that did not believe before'".

These two hadiths teach us that we still have the chance to go back to Allaah and repent provided that there is no death rattle in our throat, and the sun hasn't yet come from its west.

As for the answer to the second question, there are many verses in the Quran and many hadiths that tackle this point. In Soorat Al Zumar, Allah says what can be interpreted as; "Say: O 'Ibaadi (My slaves) who have transgressed against themselves (by committing evil deeds and sins)! Despair not of the Mercy of Allaah, verily, Allaah forgives all sins. Truly, He is Oft-Forgiving, Most Merciful" [39:53].

Allaah forgives not just the small sins but even the gravest sins. In Soorat Al Maa'idah, Allaah calls those who committed the gravest sin of shirk (associating other gods with Allaah, as they claimed Prophet Essa (Jesus) to be the son of God, exalted be Allaah far above this saying) to repent. Allaah says: "Will they not turn with repentance to Allaah and ask His forgiveness? For Allaah is Oft-Forgiving, Most Merciful"[5:74].

There is no graver sin than shirk. Allaah is calling those who committed shirk to return to Him and ask for His forgiveness. This indicates that no matter how many sins you have committed or how bigger your sins are, Allaah is Oft-Forgiving and Most Merciful. You need to remember Him, fear Him and return to Him by asking for His forgiveness.

Even hypocrites can repent. Hypocrites are actually worse than Kufaar (disbelievers) because hypocrites don't show their kufir (disbelief) and appear as if they were believers. However Allaah gives them the chance to repent:

"Verily, the hypocrites will be in the lowest depth (grade) of the Fire; no helper will you find for them.

146- Except those who repent (from hypocrisy), do righteous good deeds, hold fast to Allaah, and purify their religion for Allaah (by worshipping none but Allaah, and do good for Allaah's sake only, not to show off), then they will be with the believers. And Allaah will grant the believers a great reward" [al-Nisa' 4:145-146]

Allaah is Kind, Forgiving and Merciful. The Prophet himself used to ask for Allaah's forgiveness one hundred times a day. Although Allaah had forgiven the Prophet, the Prophet repented because he wished to show his thanks and gratitude to Allaah. So even if you think you didn't make any mistakes, it is still a good idea to keep asking for

Allaah's forgiveness. But who didn't make mistakes? Who didn't fall short? Who didn't forget to ... ? We all need to repent and return to Allaah. "And It is He Who accepts repentance from His slaves, and forgives sins, and He knows what you do"[al-Shoora 42:25] .

Repentance is beloved to Allaah. Interestingly, the Prophet (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "By the One in Whose hand is my soul, if you did not commit sin Allaah would do away with you and bring people who would commit sin then pray for forgiveness." Narrated by Muslim, 2749. Allaah loves to see us repent. The Messenger of Allaah (peace and blessings of Allaah be upon him) said: "Allaah rejoices more over the repentance of His slave than any one of you who finds his camel after having lost it in a desolate land." Agreed upon.

The question now is how to repent. Alhamdulillah we have made our minds to repent. What should we do? Well, there are sins that are between the slave and Allaah and some other sins are between the wrongdoer and other people. If the sin we committed are between us and Allaah, there are three things we must do in order to repent and so that our repentance can be considered correct. First, we should give up the sin. Second, we should regret having done it. Third, we should be determined to never go back to it. If any of these conditions are not fulfilled, the repentance is not sincere. If it is between us and other people, then along with the previous three conditions there is a fourth condition; we should restore the rights of those we did wrong to. If it is their money you took, then give it back to them. If you have been backbiting them, ask for their forgiveness. If you have slandered them, give them the chance to insult you or apologize to them and ask for their forgiveness.

If one committed a lot of sins, he or she should repent from them all. If one repents from some of those sins, the repentance from these sins which they repented from is valid. But they better repent from all their sins. We should do as Allaah says solely because it is His order and we are His slaves. We abide by Allaah's instructions with the hope that we may win His pleasure and to be saved from Hell Fire. Repentance helps us to return back from disobeying Allaah to obeying Him. So when we repent from a sin, we are trying to go back on the right track, we are just doing our homework. However, subhan Allah and Alhamdulillah Allaah rewards those who repent. It is out of His kindness and grace that those sinners who repent are rewarded in this life and in the hereafter. Allaah says:

"O you who believe! Turn to Allaah with sincere repentance! It may be that your Lord will expiate from you your sins, and admit you into Gardens under which rivers flow (Paradise) the Day that Allaah will not disgrace the Prophet (Muhammad) and those who believe with him. Their Light will run forward before them and (with their Records Books of deeds) in their right hands. They will say: 'Our Lord! Keep perfect our Light for us [and do not put it off till we cross over the Siraat (a slippery bridge over the Hell) safely] and grant us forgiveness. Verily, You are Able to do all things'" [al-Tahreem 66:8]

Those who repent will lead a good life in the shade of faith, contentment, peace of mind and tranquility. Allaah says:

"Seek the forgiveness of your Lord, and turn to Him in repentance, that He may grant you good enjoyment, for a term appointed, and bestow His abounding Grace to every owner of grace (i.e. the one who helps and serves the needy and deserving, physically and with his wealth, and even with good words)"[Hood 11:3].

Repentance is indeed a blessing from Allaah. If there was no such a blessing, what would we do after making a mistake? Alhamdulillah for this blessing and all His blessings. May Allaah forgive us all, amen.

Supplications for Seeking Forgiveness

1. سُبْحَانَكَ تَبْتُ إِلَيْكَ

Exalted are You! I have repented to You. [al-A'raaf: 143]

2. رَبِّ اغْفِرْ وَارْحَمْ وَأَنْتَ خَيْرُ الرَّحِيمِينَ

My Lord, forgive and have mercy, and You are the best of the merciful. [al-Mu'minun: 118]

3. رَبَّنَا إِنَّا أَمْنَا فَاغْفِرْ لَنَا ذُنُوبَنَا وَقِنَا عَذَابَ النَّارِ

Our Lord, indeed we have believed, so forgive us our sins and protect us from the punishment of the Fire. [Ale 'Imran: 16]

4. سَمِعْنَا وَأَطَعْنَا غُفْرَانَكَ رَبَّنَا وَإِلَيْكَ الْمَصِيرُ

We hear and we obey. [We seek] Your forgiveness, our Lord, and to You is the [final] destination. [al-Baqarah: 285]

5. أَنْتَ وَلِيُّنَا فَاغْفِرْ لَنَا وَارْحَمْنَا وَأَنْتَ خَيْرُ الْغَافِرِينَ

You are our Protector, so forgive us and have mercy upon us; and You are the best of forgivers. [al-A'raaf: 155]

6. رَبَّنَا أَتِمِّمْ لَنَا نُورَنَا وَاعْفِرْ لَنَا إِنَّكَ عَلَىٰ كُلِّ شَيْءٍ قَدِيرٌ

Our Lord, perfect for us our light and forgive us. Indeed, You are over all things competent. [al-Tahrim: 8]
